Talking Points

- Giving Kitchen offers financial assistance food service workers that get hurt or sick, lose a family member, or suffer a housing disaster like a flood or fire. When crisis strikes and they miss work, GK makes sure they can still pay their bills.
- Through their Stability Network, GK can connect food service workers in crisis to resources that they may have not been aware of, from housing and utilities to health and wellness to employment and more.
- The food service community needs Giving Kitchen to have their back. Food service is one of the most important industries in our economy, but employs some of the most vulnerable of us. The work GK does keeps families together, prevents homelessness, and provides hope in the darkest of times.
- In a recent survey:
 - o 75% of GK financial assistance clients reported that GK helped prevent eviction
 - 68% of GK financial assistance clients reported they didn't have to skip meals to pay bills.
- Giving Kitchen serves food service workers in all 50 states and U.S. territories.
- Giving Kitchen's case management team can speak to food service workers in 188 languages.
